

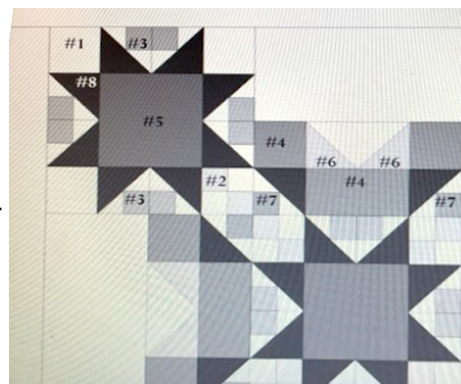
Grand Isle Cutting Instructions ~ 66" x 88"

- WOF means width of fabric. LOF means length of fabric.
- Label pieces as indicated by letters/numbers in **Bold** in the cutting instructions.
- Alternate cutting instructions for using the Cat's Cradle tool by Creative Grids are listed beginning on page 2. I strongly suggest using this wonderful tool for making the "Cat's Cradle" units. There are no bias seams and it's really fun to use. ☺
- To cut squares once on the diagonal, cut squares as shown in diagram.



Fabric #1:

- Cut 4 – 6 ½" strips WOF. From strips, cut 10 – 6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles (**A**) and 10 – 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles (**B**).
- Cut 1 – 4 ¾" strip WOF. From strip, cut 7 – 4 ¾" squares (**C**).
- Cut 2 – 3 ½" strips WOF. From strips, cut 24 – 3 ½" squares (**D**).
- Cut 12 – 2 3/8" strips WOF. From strips, cut 192 – 2 3/8" squares. Cut squares once on the diagonal (**E**).
- Cut 5 – 2" strips WOF for Four Patch Units.
- Cut 5 – 3 ½" strips WOF for side borders.
- Cut 4 – 2 ½" strips WOF for top and bottom borders.



Fabric #2:

- Cut 5 – 2" strips WOF for Four Patch Units.

Fabric #3:

- Cut 7 – 2" strips WOF. From strips, cut 144 – 2" squares (**F**).

Fabric #4:

- Cut 8 – 3 ½" strips WOF. From strips, cut 38 – 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles (**G**) and 20 – 3 ½" squares (**H**).

Fabric #5:

- Cut 3 – 6 ½" strips WOF. From strips, cut 18 – 6 ½" squares (**I**).

Fabric #6:

- Cut 2 – 4" strips WOF. From strips, cut 14 – 4" squares. Cut squares once on the diagonal (**J**).
- Cut 2 – 3 ½" strips WOF. From strips, cut 20 – 3 ½" squares (**K**).

Fabric #7:

- Cut 3 – 2" strips WOF. From strips, cut 48 – 2" squares (**L**).
- Cut 8 – 2 ¼" strips WOF for binding.

Fabric #8:

- Cut 10 – 4” strips WOF. From strips, cut 96 – 4” squares. Cut squares once on the diagonal (**M**).

Alternate Cutting for using the Cat's Cradle Tool ~

Fabric #1:

- Cut 4 – 6 ½” strips WOF. From strips, cut 10 – 6 ½” x 12 ½” rectangles (**A**) and 10 – 3 ½” x 6 ½” rectangles (**B**).
- Cut 1 – 4 ¾” strip WOF. From strip, cut 7 – 4 ¾” squares (**C**).
- Cut 2 – 3 ½” strips WOF. From strips, cut 24 – 3 ½” squares (**D**).
- Cut 10 – 3 ¼” strips WOF. From strips, cut 192 – 2 ¼” x 3 ¼” rectangles (**E**).
- Cut 5 – 2” strips WOF for Four Patch Units.
- Cut 4 – 3 ½” strips WOF for side borders.
- Cut 4 – 2 ½” strips WOF for top and bottom borders.

Fabric #2:

- Cut 5 – 2” strips WOF for Four Patch Units.

Fabric #3:

- Cut 8 – 2 ¼” strips WOF. From strips, cut 144 – 2 ¼” squares (**F**).

Fabric #4:

- Cut 8 – 3 ½” strips WOF. From strips, cut 38 – 3 ½” x 6 ½” rectangles (**G**) and 20 – 3 ½” squares (**H**).

Fabric #5:

- Cut 3 – 6 ½” strips WOF. From strips, cut 18 – 6 ½” squares (**I**).

Fabric #6:

- Cut 2 – 4” strips WOF. From strips, cut 14 – 4” squares. Cut squares once on the diagonal (**J**).
- Cut 2 – 3 ½” strips WOF. From strips, cut 20 – 3 ½” squares (**K**).

Fabric #7:

- Cut 3 – 2 ¼” strips WOF. From strips, cut 48 – 2 ¼” squares (**L**).
- Cut 8 – 2 ¼” strips WOF for binding.

Fabric #8:

- Cut 12 – 4” strips WOF. From strips, cut 96 – 4” x 5” rectangles (**M**).

Grand Isle Cutting Instructions ~ 42" x 42"

Fabric #1:

- Cut 2 – 6 ½" strips WOF. From strips, cut 4 – 6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles **(A)** and 4 – 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles **(B)**.
- Cut 1 – 3 ½" strip WOF. From strip, cut 12 – 3 ½" squares **(D)**.
- Cut 3 – 2 3/8" strips WOF. From strips, cut 48 – 2 3/8" squares. Cut squares once on the diagonal **(E)**.
- Cut 1 – 2" strip WOF for Four Patch Units.
- Cut 4 – 3 ½" strips WOF for borders.

Fabric #2:

- Cut 1 – 2" strip WOF for Four Patch Units.

Fabric #3:

- Cut 2 – 2" strips WOF. From strips, cut 40 – 2" squares **(F)**.

Fabric #4:

- Cut 2 – 3 ½" strips WOF. From strips, cut 4 – 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles **(G)** and 8 – 3 ½" squares **(H)**.

Fabric #5:

- Cut 1 – 6 ½" strip WOF. From strips, cut 5 – 6 ½" squares **(I)**.

Fabric #6:

- Cut 1 – 3 ½" strip WOF. From strip, cut 8 – 3 ½" squares **(K)**.

Fabric #7:

- Cut 1 – 2" strip WOF. From strip, cut 8 – 2" squares **(L)**.
- Cut 4 – 2 ¼" strips WOF for binding.

Fabric #8:

- Cut 3 – 4" strips WOF. From strips, cut 24 – 4" squares. Cut squares once on the diagonal **(M)**.

Alternate Cutting for using the Cat's Cradle Tool ~

Fabric #1:

- Cut 2 – 6 ½" strips WOF. From strips, cut 4 – 6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles **(A)** and 4 – 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles **(B)**.
- Cut 1 – 3 ½" strips WOF. From strips, cut 12 – 3 ½" squares **(D)**.
- Cut 3 – 3 ¼" strips WOF. From strips, cut 48 – 2 ¼" x 3 ¼" rectangles **(E)**.
- Cut 1 – 2" strip WOF for Four Patch Units.
- Cut 4 – 3 ½" strips WOF for borders.

Fabric #2:

- Cut 1 – 2” strip WOF for Four Patch Units.

Fabric #3:

- Cut 3 – 2 ¼” strips WOF. From strips, cut 40 – 2 ¼” squares **(F)**.

Fabric #4:

- Cut 2 – 3 ½” strips WOF. From strips, cut 4 – 3 ½” x 6 ½” rectangles **(G)** and 8 – 3 ½” squares **(H)**.

Fabric #5:

- Cut 1 – 6 ½” strip WOF. From strip, cut 5 – 6 ½” squares **(I)**.

Fabric #6:

- Cut 1 – 3 ½” strip WOF. From strip, cut 8 – 3 ½” squares **(K)**.

Fabric #7:

- Cut 1 – 2 ¼” strip WOF. From strip, cut 8 – 2 ¼” squares **(L)**.
- Cut 4 – 2 ¼” strips WOF for binding.

Fabric #8:

- Cut 3 – 4” strips WOF. From strips, cut 24 – 4” x 5” rectangles **(M)**.
