LYNN DYKSTRA Using Solids with Prints AND how to use up the Bits

Cost: \$40 member/\$45 non-member

There is a sewing machine or no sewing machine option for this class.

- Bring cutting matt/cutter/ruler and pins or clips to group your block decisions.
- Ruler: I like to use a 6 by 12-inch ruler.
- If sewing, also bring your machine and all needed to piece.
- Bring eights or quarters of 6+ prints and 4+ of Kona or Moda Bella solids to the workshop. They do not need to match. **We will share solids and prints in making a few simple locks that will showcase those prints.**
- **Also bring a couple of handfuls of scraps to cut down.**
- **Fabrics for this workshop can be a wide variety of everything.**
OR they can be focused: Darks and brights, reds, low volumes, etc
(If your prints are too precious to share, that is ok—you don't have to!)

Included will be cutting and pressing tips to maximize efficiency. We will make blocks for the Horizon quilt shown below. You will also cut down the remaining scraps into bits and learn how to organize for a second (or third!) quilt.

In the afternoon, you can continue to work on your Horizon quilt OR switch to a Bits (Coin) quilt.

Will you finish a top? No! But we will get a lot done!

Optional—show and tell piece to share over lunch.
